The Court, being duly advised in the premises and upon all the files, records and proceedings held herein, now finds, by clear and convincing evidence, the following:

FINDINGS OF FACT

- At a hearing on January 22, 2024, and in a written order issued January 23, 2024, Winona
 County District Court committed Respondent as a person who poses a risk of harm due to a
 mental illness to the custody of Prairie St. John's and the Commissioner of the Minnesota
 Department of Human Services for a period not to exceed six (6) months.
- On July 15, 2024, Winona County filed a request to extend the civil commitment of Respondent.
- The matter was initially scheduled for hearing on July 22, 2024, at 8:30 a.m. On July 16,
 2024, counsel for Respondent filed a request to continue the hearing and to appoint a second examiner.
- 4. The Court granted the request to continue the hearing and appoint a second examiner. The hearing was reset to July 31, 2024. This date is outside the scheduled expiration of the commitment.
- 5. There is good cause to extend the commitment due to court and attorney availability as well as the request for a second examiner.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 1. Pursuant to Minn. Stat. § 253B.12 subd. 2a(a), a commitment may be extended until a review hearing is held for good cause shown.
 - a. There is good cause shown due to court and attorney availability as well as the request for a second examiner.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

- 1. The previously issued civil commitment order dated January 23, 2024, is extended through the date of the review hearing set for July 31, 2024.
- 2. The review hearing is scheduled for July 31, 2024, at 9:00 a.m. before the Honorable Carmaine Sturino.
